

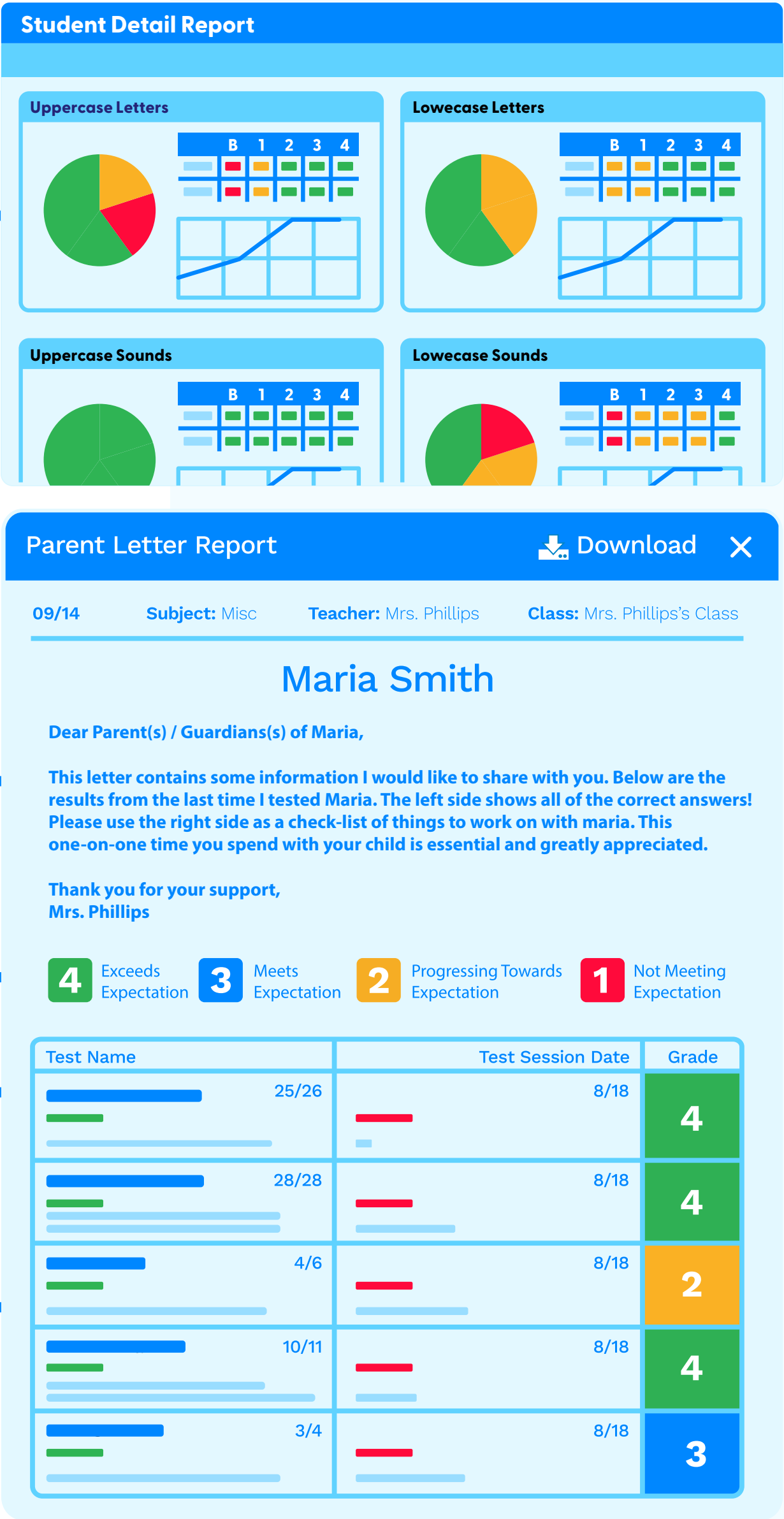
# Better Report Cards with ESGI

## How to Create a Report Card with ESGI

1. Complete student assessments across the desired skills and subjects.
2. Generate the Student Detail Report for each student. This report shows individual performance on specific assessments, highlighting mastered and unmastered skills.
3. Generate the Parent Letter. This includes overall summaries, skill areas, and grade scales, and is available in multiple languages.
4. Combine both reports by printing them together or stapling them into a single packet.
5. Send the combined report home to families as your report card substitute or supplement.
